GVI CLUB PREMISES AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made at Greater Noida, on this **Fifth** day of September 2026

BY AND BETWEEN

GURJINDER VIHAR INSTITUTE AND COMMUNITY CLUB, AWHO TOWNSHIP, SECTOR CHI-1, POCKET P-5, GREATER NOIDA (UP) - 201310, through its authorized representative/ signatory, Secretary GVI, (hereinafter referred to as the "GVI", which expression shall, unless excluded by or repugnant to the content or meaning thereof, be deemed to include its successors and assigns), the **FIRST PARTY**

AND

The **CORPORATE CLUB HOSPITALITY** represented by its proprietor **SANTOSH MISHRA S/o Shri JAIDEV MISHRA**, having its office at **GUO5 SECT 42, NOIDA**, (hereinafter referred to as the "Caterer", which expression shall, unless excluded by or repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to include its successors and assigns), the **SECOND PARTY**.

The **FIRST PARTY** and the **SECOND PARTY** jointly are referred to as **PARTIES**.

NOW, THEREFORE, THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS UNDER

1. The FIRST PARTY is desirous of having the services of a caterer to operate its catering services in GVI and the SECOND PARTY is desirous of providing the catering services at GVI and had submitted its bid through a tendering process and evaluated by a Board of Officers detailed by GVI and has been shortlisted to provide its services.
2. The PARTIES hereby agree to abide by the terms and conditions as mentioned in this agreement in the succeeding paragraphs.

Obligations of the FIRST PARTY

3. The GVI shall provide a kitchen and cafeteria space of the Club as under:-
 - a) The kitchen, pantry and main dining hall to the Caterer.
 - b) One prepaid meter at the Main Dining Hall to provide electricity in the restaurant (including the kitchen) of the Club having a load capacity of 25 KW with a power backup to meet the requirement of the caterer.
 - c) PNG Gas connection in the kitchen. LPG cylinder use is not permitted in the GVI.
4. The GVI shall provide water connection in the entire club premises including kitchen. A RO shall also be provided in Kitchen which shall be maintained by the GVI.
5. Furniture, ACs, ceiling fans and lighting infrastructure shall be made available by the GVI.
6. The GVI shall provide intercom telephone facilities in kitchen, cafeteria, banquet halls and other spaces of the Club.
7. The caterer is permitted to offer catering services at Community Center called GVCC (capacity 400-500 pax), as per rules and regulation of GVCC or any other place within Gurjinder Vihar after due approval of RWA AWHO GVGN for the event.
8. Through this agreement, the caterer is hereby given an exclusive right to provide catering services within GVI premises including lawns. However outside caterers/ shops may be permitted by the FIRST PARTY for limited snack items that cannot be provided by the caterer such as chaat items, jalebi, Samosa etc at the discretion of the FIRST PARTY.

9. As and when central functions are held and where food stalls are established, the caterer may be given an option to establish stalls as decided by RWA. However, if RWA so desires, it is mandatory for caterer to setup stall in such functions.

Obligations of the SECOND PARTY

10. The caterer will provide catering services in the Club premises, including Cafeteria/ rooms in the club and at all other areas within the premises of the club where catering of food, meals and snacks may be required. The caterer shall also be required to cater to all parties, banquets and other functions as may be organized by the Club, or its members in the Club premises. He will ensure availability of chef and service staff for serving breakfast from 0700 hour onwards in the guest rooms and designated club premises. The Contractor must employ a professionally qualified and experienced Manager to be available in the Restaurant between 10:00 AM to 10:00 PM & during any function in Party halls or Lawn to attend to any requirement or complaints. Such manager shall however be deployed only after he/she is interviewed and approved by the Secretary GVI.

11. There are FIVE party halls in GVI of capacity 25-100 which shall be booked directly by GVI and the club caterer will provide catering and decoration services in them as per requirement projected to him by the organizer.

12. In addition, catering services will also be provided in Restaurant, Bar and other places including lawns within the GVI premises.

13. The caterer will provide home delivery services within the society at no additional charges and within reasonable time.

14. The caterer is not permitted to supply food outside the Gurjinder Vihar Township.

15. The Intercom facility provided by GVI shall be lawfully used with due care by the caterer to provide best services to the residents/guests in the club. The caterer undertakes to replace the instrument without any cost of the FIRST PARTY, if damaged during the term of this contract.

16. Payment of PNG and Electricity Charges.

(a) The monthly bill of PNG shall be paid by the caterer. As the bill of the PNG is in the name of the Secretary GVI, it is received by him and he will hand over the same to caterer well before due date. Second Party understands that if the payment is delayed, the caterer has to pay

the penalty imposed by the PNG supplying company.

(b) Electricity will be provided at the site (Kitchen and Restaurant) by the Secretary GVI on payment from the contractor. Electricity charges will be recovered from the contractor through pre-paid meter installed for the purpose.

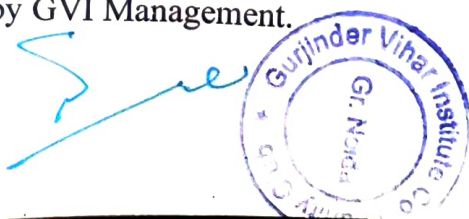
17. Place for housing of six staff shall be provided by GVI at no cost, all other staff shall be housed outside the society under caterer's own arrangement.

18. The GVI lawn is given by GVI for marriages/ get togethers/ parties and other activities. The lawn has a capacity of about 300 guests. The caterer agrees to provide all catering and decoration services as per fixed menu and rates.

19. Party and Restaurant Menu and rates duly approved by the Management Committee of the GVI at the time of signing of this agreement are attached at Appendix A. The caterer shall charge as per approved rates as decided by GVI Management Committee. New items as and when added will be finalized between the Caterer and the Secretary GVI and shall be prominently displayed including My Gate services. Bulk orders for Kitty parties, Regimental/ Course get togethers will be taken directly from the organizer of the party. However, for ladies meet order will be taken minimum 2 days in advance for making necessary arrangements.

20. The Caterer shall ensure that the food and the raw materials are of approved quality. Caterer shall always maintain the standards as prescribed by prevention of food adulteration laws and regulations in force. The caterer specifically agrees to be bound by any consequences and claims on account of adverse consequences being suffered by the GVI for the reason of any substandard food item or drink being served. The Caterer shall be responsible for all third-party claims, and any liability whatsoever, arising out of any claim, complaint or other action initiated by any party on account of poor quality food or service, or on account of any complaint pertaining to the products and services of the Caterer. The caterer agrees to keep indemnified the Club against any loss or damage that may be suffered by it on account of any breach of law, agreement, or on account of the breach of any other obligation committed by the caterer towards any party.

21. Special Conditions for Non-Veg Food. It will be ensured that only Jhatka meat is served. This shall be purchased only from authorised sources/ vendors, duly licensed by the municipal authorities. Necessary checks for these matters be carried out by GVI Management.

22. If there is dispute between the caterer and any resident regarding the quality of service or food provided, the matter shall be resolved by Secretary GVI and this ruling shall be final and binding on both parties.
23. The cleanliness of the cooking areas, ground kitchen and the serving counters for meals as well as personal hygiene of staff preparing and serving food shall be impeccable and of high standard. To ensure that hygiene of the restaurant including Kitchen area and of the staff deployed in the restaurant is of requisite standard, a fortnightly check will be carried out by the Secretary GVI/his representative including a doctor if possible. Shortcomings noticed shall be rectified within two days of the inspection. Repeated observation will however, be dealt with strictly and may result in a penalty of Rs 5000/, at the sole discretion of the Secretary GVI. Contract may even be terminated if no improvement is seen by GVI Management Committee.
24. If the rates are to be revised on a higher side, the caterer shall give an application to the Secretary who after getting it ratified by the Management Committee shall approve it and caterer shall implement it. The decision of the Management Committee shall be final in this regard.
25. The caterer shall provide additional staff for events and functions other than routine club activities e.g. GVCC/ Party halls etc. as per the instructions by the First Party.
26. The caterer may install his own telephone and internet connection after due permission of Secretary of GVI.
27. The caterer shall arrange all crockery, cutlery, tableware, linen, napkins, carry bags and all other items of good standard and quality with due approval of GVI Secretary, as required for serving or packing food items. Plastic crockery and other banned items will not be used inside GVI premises. Furniture items for a strength of 50 will be kept in GVI by the caterer.
28. The caterer shall appoint well qualified and well trained staff; including Stewards, Waiters, Chefs, Assistants, Service Captains and all other staff, including persons for washing and maintenance, to the satisfaction of GVI. The Contractor will verify the character antecedents of all staff employed by him and obtain police verification before they are deployed in GVI. Contractor will employ them at his own risk. Also, their police verification will be submitted with GVI before their employment. Dress code set by GVI Management will be strictly adhered by all persons employed in GVI.

40. All equipment handed over to the caterer will be in working condition. Specified equipment, stores and other items as per inventory belonging to the GVI and placed under charge of the Second Party for facilitating the operation of the club will be kept clean and maintained by the Second Party at his cost. These will be handed over back to the GVI in a maintained and working condition on termination of the contract. The agreement can be terminated if violation is found in this regard.

41. Consumption of tobacco, alcohol, paan, cigarettes or any other toxic product by the staff of caterer on GVI premises is strictly prohibited.

42. The restaurant premises are to be used only for the purpose of running the restaurant for Gurjinder Vihar and not for any other purpose in any manner. The contractor or his staff shall not use the premises for any other business purpose.

43. The caterer shall not give the premises or any part of it and catering services for subletting in any manner. Any violation of this clause may lead to a penalty of Rs 5000 - per violation or as decided by the Secretary GVI. Repeated violations may also lead to termination of this agreement.

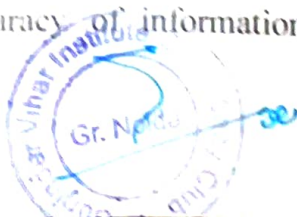
44. The Second Party will take all necessary precautions to prevent any fire outbreak in the restaurant and kitchen. He shall be solely responsible and liable for any fire incident occurring in the premises under his charge. It will be ensured that his staff is well trained in handling the fire equipment.

45. The Second Party will provide the following documents to the GVI :-

- (a) Copy of GST Registration.
- (b) Copy of Shop and Establishment License.
- (c) Copy of Food Business Operator license from FSSAI.
- (d) Certificate on Company Letter head stating that the Second Party follows the Minimum Wage Act and other rules pertaining to PF Act, ESI Act, Workman Compensation Act and other rules laid down by the Central and State Governments. Copies of PAN, TAN, Income Tax returns for the past two years and Balance sheet for the past two years will also be made available.

46. In case his contract is cancelled at any other location for any reason whatsoever during the term of this contract, he shall inform the GVI on company letter head of the same immediately.

47. Accuracy of information of any kind on part of caterer should be maintained.

TERM, RENEWAL AND TERMINATION

48. This agreement commences from the effective date which is 05 September 2026.

49. The term of this agreement shall be three years with a condition that it will be renewed every year based on the performance and feedback received from the environment and shall cease to exist after 04 September 2029 unless renewed by both PARTIES.

50. Either Party can terminate the contract by giving three months (90 days) notice after giving detailed reasons for the termination to the other party and should be acceptable by both. However, there will be a lock in period of six (06) months binding on both parties from the date of the agreement.

51. Notwithstanding the terms and conditions given in paras above, GVI reserves the right to terminate the services in case of :-

- (a) Non-payment of dues to the GVI by the caterer.
- (b) Gross misconduct by the caterer or his Staff.
- (c) Serious nature of complaints by the members.
- (d) Non adherence to the directions given by Management Committee.

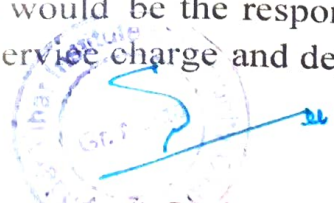
RENT AND PAYMENTS

52. The Caterer shall pay a monthly lease rent of Rs. 2,25,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Twenty Five Thousand only) which includes all services at Restaurants, take away orders and guest rooms to the GVI office on first working day of every month in advance. Under no circumstances the caterer will deduct any amount for PNG or Electricity charges from the lease rent amount. Delay in payment beyond 5th of the month will invite a penalty of Rs 1000/- per day.

53. Caterer will also pay 5% of the total charges collected by him for the catering and decoration service for all the parties (except for Ladies Meet, Regimental Parties and Course get-togethers) whether in any hall or in the lawn, besides above fixed monthly lease rent, latest by 05th of subsequent month directly to the GVI.

54. GST as applicable shall be paid by caterer in addition to the rent amount as shown above.

55. It would be the responsibility of the caterer to collect the taxes and/or service charge and deposit the applicable taxes with the

concerned authorities within time. In case the Club suffers any recovery, loss, or damage whatsoever on account of any default on the part of the Caterer in fulfilling any statutory obligation, the Club shall be entitled to make recovery of compensation for such loss from the Caterer. The Caterer hereby indemnifies the Club against any such loss or damage. In the event of its failure to fulfill any obligation, the Club will be entitled to meet the said obligation and recover the same by means of deduction from any amount payable to the Caterer, including the security deposit.

56. The Caterer shall compulsorily make all the billings of the restaurant through GVI smart card only with effect from 01 September 2026. All necessary arrangement like computer, printer, UPS etc. will be arranged by the Second Party in this regard. Monthly payments will be made by GVI to reimburse the collected amount after subtracting dues, if any, of the First Party.

57. Caterer shall be liable to pay the charges for lifting the kitchen garbage properly packed in the disposable garbage bags.

SECURITY DEPOSIT

58. The Caterer shall deposit with Treasurer GVI an interest free Security Deposit of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five lacs only) through a Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG). GVI shall have the right to forfeit or deduct out of the ibid deposit any amount which the Second Party may become liable hereunder and shall refund the balance money to the Second Party on completion or termination of the Contract. GVI/RWA has the authority to withhold the payment to be made to the Second Party for failure to discharge any of his obligation.

TIMINGS

59. GVI restaurant will remain open on all week days except Tuesday & designated closed holidays as per the following timings :-

- (a) Summer: 10:00 AM to 10:30 PM
- (b) Winter: 10:30 AM to 10:00 PM.

60. Tuesday will be observed as maintenance day. However, all meals for the guests staying in the guest rooms shall be provided as per their demand on closed days.

63. This Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which collectively shall be deemed one and the same instrument.
